

# Training and Trainers

Personnel of Maharashtra Security Force are at present trained at the premises of Group VIII of State Reserve Police Force, Goregaon, Mumbai.

After selection, Force personnel undergo rigorous training. Typical training comprises of:

- Physical fitness and endurance
- Drill
- Arms drill and weapon handling
- Tactical requirements for the job
- Details of bombs, IEDs and techniques of their detection
- Fire fighting
- Crowd and Traffic management
- Disaster management and emergency protocol
- Constitution of India and various laws
- First aid and rescue etc.

At present, Force personnel are being trained by personnel of Special Reserve Police Force (SRPF) of Maharashtra, officers of Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad (BDDS), instructors of Maharashtra Intelligence Academy (MIA), Pune and Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Government of India
